

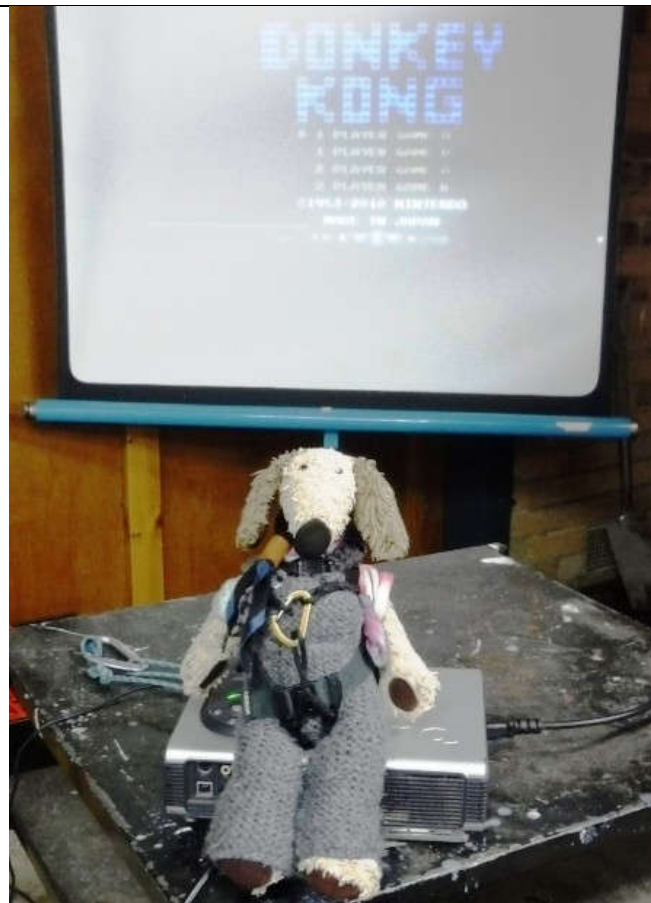

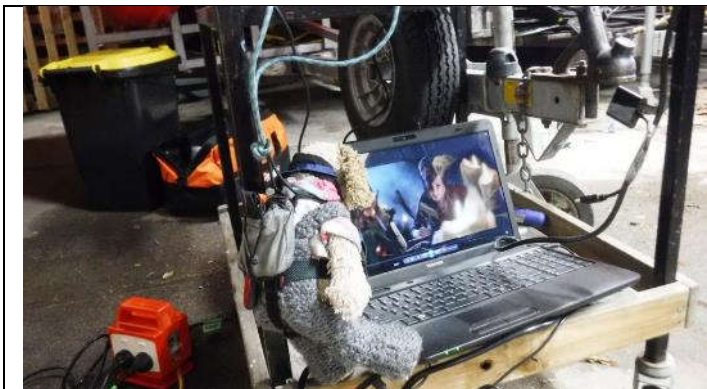

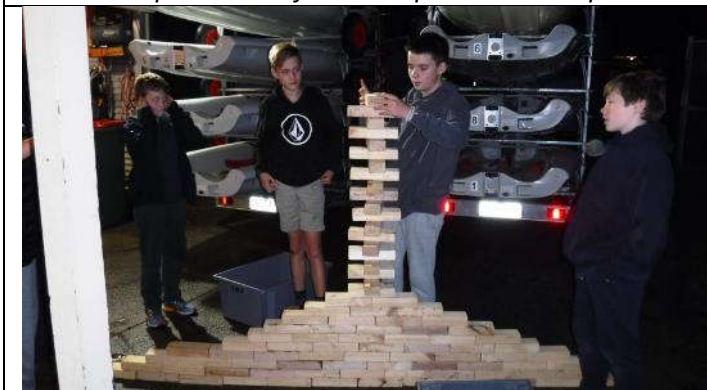
First Scuffie had to Check that the Games were in theme and all related Gaming tech were set up properly.

But this one was Stable. Stable enough for a Famous Celebrity to Climb...



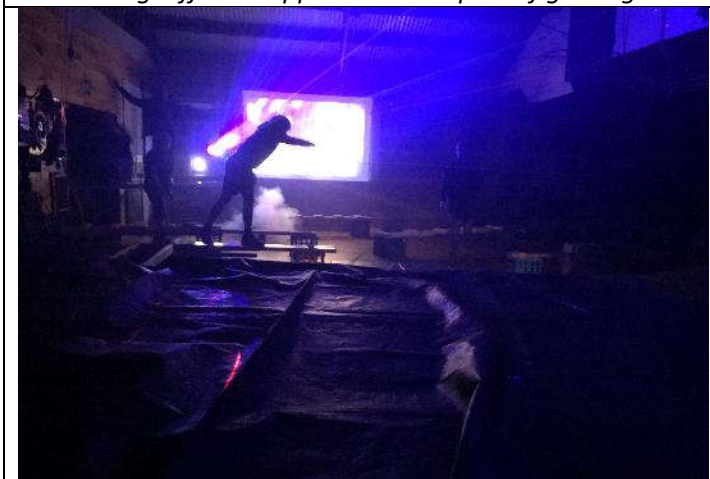
Giant Rubic Cube. Tetris on the Right.
